

Parents,

After meeting with our staff, we decided this will be the plan we will begin with:

Arrival:

Kindergarten will go to the front door of school where their temperature will be taken before entering.

1st – 2nd will go to the back door of the school where their temperature will be taken before entering.

3rd – 5th will go to the side ramp of the Chapel where their temperature will be taken.

6th – 8th will go to the back door of the gym where their temperature will be taken.

9th – 12th will go in the front door of the gym building where their temperature will be taken.

*All parents are asked to stay in the car during this time. Please do not leave until your child has been cleared to enter the school. We will have 2 teachers at each door. Please be patient as we strive to do this. Remember it is new for each of us too.

Dismissal:

Each class will have a specific spot that they will be standing in the afternoon. 1st – 2nd will dismiss at the back door. Kindergarten and 3rd – 5th will be out in front of main building.

6th – 8th will be in the back area of the gym. 9th – 12th will dismiss through the front door. Again, please be patient as we work together to make this work.

Dress Code:

Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday uniform pants with a polo shirt, Christian t-shirt, or A.C.S. shirt should be worn. On Tuesday for \$1, students may dress down. On Friday, they may dress down.

*If leggings are worn, the shirt must come past their bottom. They must have their belt on if pants have belt loops. Any violations of dress code will be addressed during temperature checks. Therefore, please make sure your child is following our dress code policy.

Snacks/Lunch:

We will not be using microwaves at this time. Students will be eating snack and lunch in their rooms. Please send snack, lunches, drink, and water. We will not be using the water fountains.

We have had a few parents asking if we would consider remote learning as we begin this school year. We met as teachers on Tuesday, and they were all in agreement to look further into this as a possibility. We have a couple of ladies who train their school system who will be meeting with us on Friday, August 7, to help us in trying to see if we can set this up for those who feel they would like to have this option. More details will be coming after Friday's session to see if this can be done efficiently and effectively.

Teachers will be contacting their parents to set up times that you may come in and meet the teacher if you would like. They will try to coordinate times if you have more than one child in our school.
